SAMBA Resident Mentorship guidelines:

1. Your resident will contact you via email to discuss the SAMBA "Roadmap for Success" worksheet. It is their responsibility to make contact with you.

2. Discuss via email or telephone the resident's worksheet and advise them as to a possible means to attaining their career goals. *Your perspective and experience are extremely valuable in this process.*

3. Review the resident's CV which should be emailed with the "Roadmap for Success" worksheet and help them with formatting and content issues.

4. If possible, settle on a time to meet in person during a coffee break at the annual meeting and/or at the mid-year meeting/ASA.

5. Encourage the resident member to submit an abstract for presentation at the annual meeting.

6. Encourage the resident member to join a SAMBA committee.

As resident members are the future active members of our society, your work as a mentor has the potential to shape the future of the society at large.
